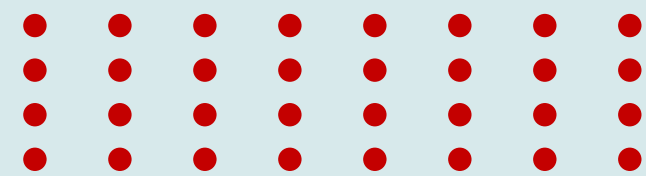
Evolving with Purpose

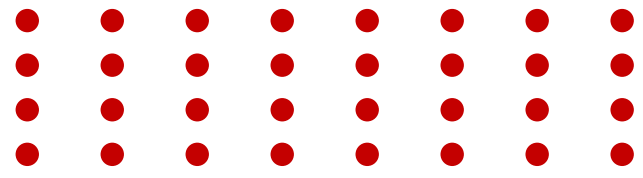
Building health equity in our community

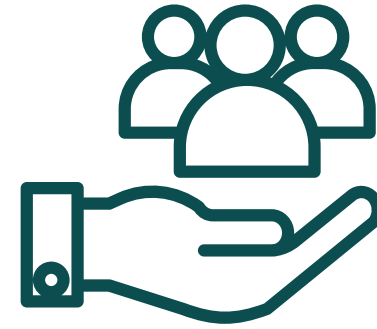

Participated in **359** events. We distributed over **24,000** condoms and **64** home-based HIV test kits.

Food and medicine: **\$449,380.56**

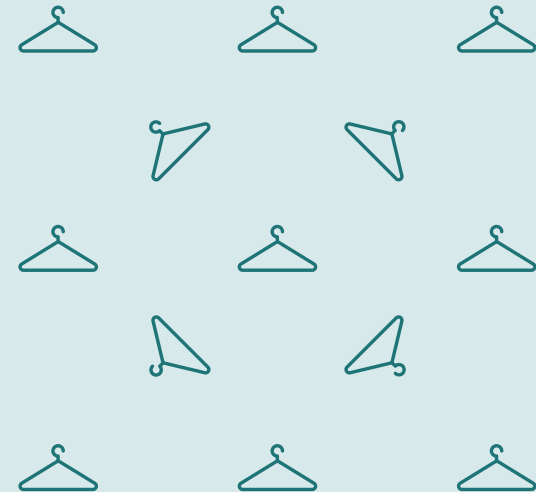

Health Programs

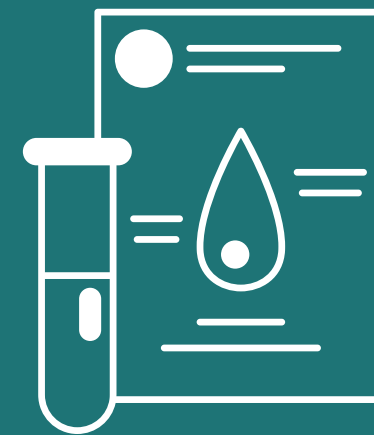
51 clients participated in the Passport to Health program

Syphilis Testing

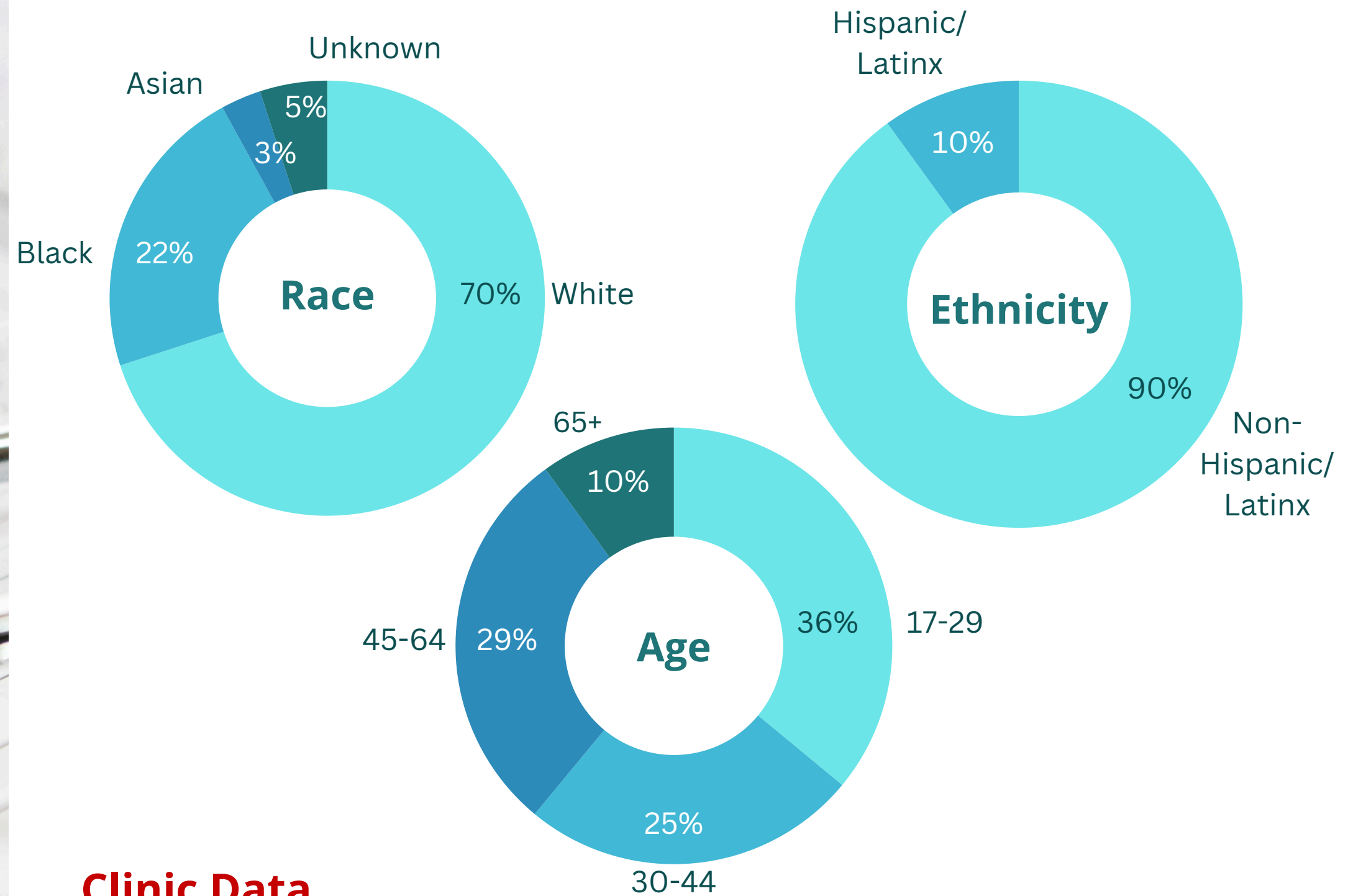
71 syphilis tests were conducted

51 primary care patients underwent mental health screenings

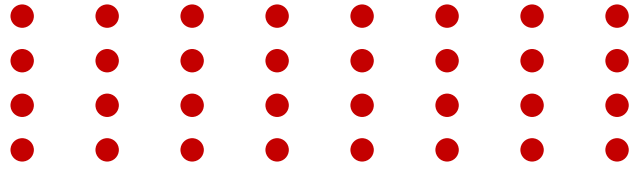

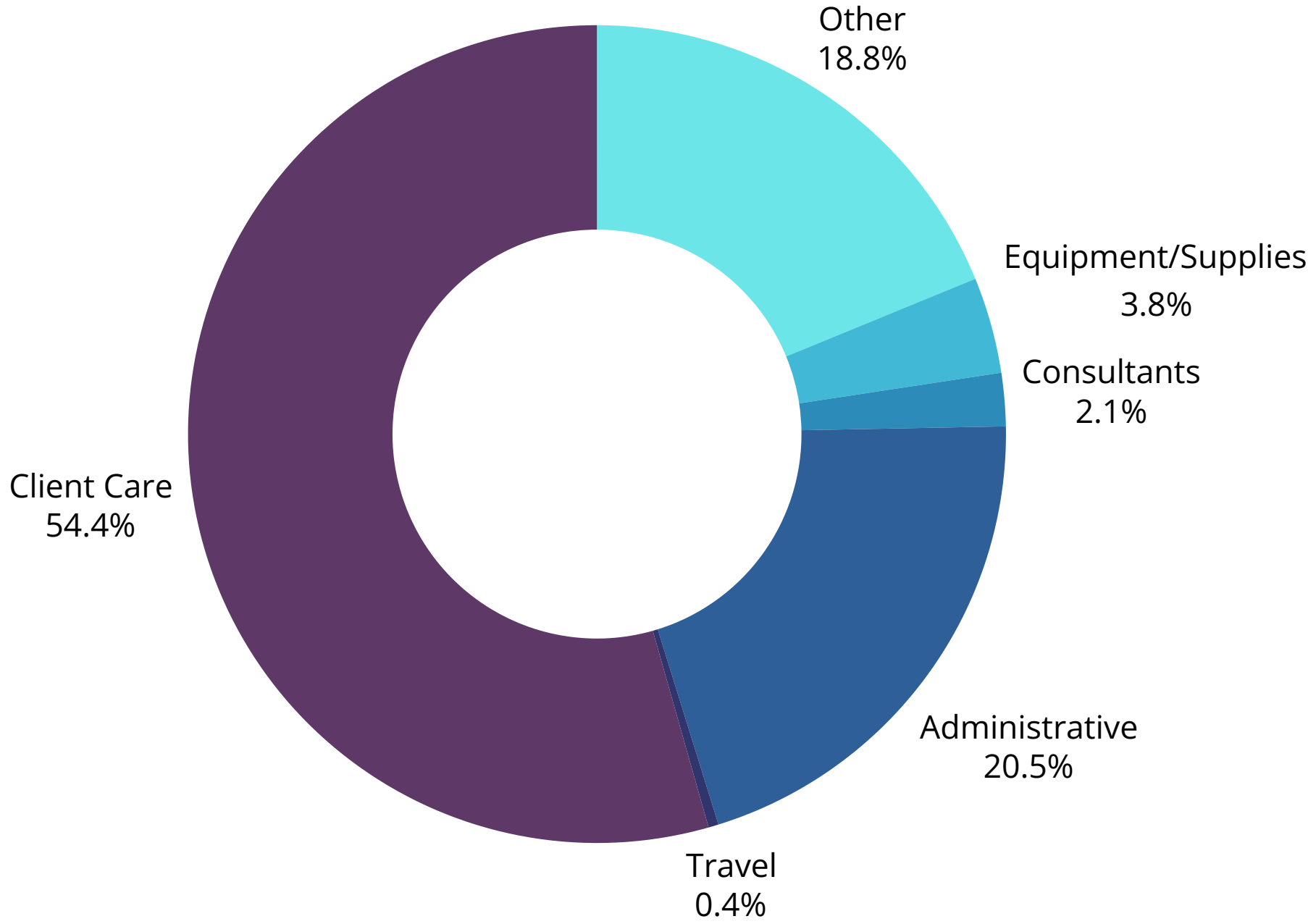
Clinic Data
